Citizen Band (CB) Radio Guidance

- While driving, radios may be used to **passively** receive operational/business information (listening) but **active** use (sending information) must be kept to a minimum
- The active use of CB radios while driving is restricted to the passage of critical safety information such as:
 - Adverse weather conditions (i.e. restricted visibility (i.e. fog), high winds, heavy rain, black ice, & winter conditions...)
 - Reporting road obstructions, hazards, and incidents if part of a convoy
 - Calling corners to alert oncoming drivers of an approach to a blind corner or breaching a hill
 - Calling Kilometers/miles if required by location rules
- Before a company allows active use of CB radios, the company must:
 - Include this usage in its Journey Management Planning
 - Document the use in the driver's Job Safety Analysis/Assessment
- Active use that is non Safety related or time sensitive is NOT allowed
- All persons will use proper radio etiquette
